- Couple: under \$50,000 in year 2023
- Each additional family member + \$2,500
- Less than \$1,000 interest income
 - No self-employment income, business income, employment expenses, bankruptcy
 - o **No** rental income
 - o **No** Capital Gains or Losses
 - No students
 - o **No** deceased persons

We do not prepare tax returns for newcomers to Canada who are filing a tax return for the first time.

Please bring <u>all</u> necessary documentation to your appointment (for example):

- Social Insurance Number and Gov't issued photo identification
- T4, T4A, T4RSP, T4RIF, T5, T5007 slips for current year
- medical receipts, children's fitness receipts, transportation expense receipts
- copy of your last year's Notice of Assessment and/or Income Tax papers
